We are excited and pleased to welcome you to our Faith Formation program this year. We will be working on the theme "The Way of the Gospel" throughout the year. During the Faith Formation Year, we'll be inviting you to join us in your child's classroom, at a special event or to work with your children at home.

The first Faith Formation class for this fall will be held on Sunday 9/17/2023. Classes for all 3 campuses are held **immediately following the 8:30 AM Mass in the Church Hall at Saint Patrick's on Keibel Rd. Whitney Point, and last until 11:00 AM.** 

\*<u>All children</u> entering Kindergarten - through High School (Confirmation) are welcome and encouraged to attend classes! You will find the '23 – '24 schedule on pages 3 and 4 of this handbook.

Classes are held an average of **2 Sundays per month.** Special Classes and Service Projects are scheduled for a few Saturdays as well.

### For children ages 3 years – 2<sup>nd</sup> grade, a Children's Liturgy of the Word is offered.

We understand the commitments our students make outside of Church and always take that into consideration when planning our Class Schedule and events. Happenings involving local school districts are taken into consideration when the catechetical year is being planned. We do, however, ask that parents prioritize Mass attendance.

#### Faith Formation Guidelines

Students in grades kindergarten through 5 will use the Pflaum Gospel Weeklies Program. During the weeks when there are no classes students and parents will work together on the weekly program and return the completed worksheets to their teachers at the next class. The children will participate in class prayer, discussion and activities, special liturgies, and service projects throughout the year. Please support their efforts.

#### Grade Kindergarten and 1

**Parents**: Life and faith are interwoven throughout each lesson as children are helped to discover what difference it makes to be a person of faith. Weekly handouts are sent home throughout the year so that you can review the lesson with your child. Bible stories are enjoyed this year. **New Prayers to know: The Sign of the Cross, Hail Mary and Glory Be.** 

#### Grade 2

**Parents**: Encourage your child to share with you about all that he or she is learning in class. Children will be preparing for the celebrations of First Reconciliation and First Communion. **New prayers to know: The Our Father and the Act of Contrition** 

#### Grade 3, 4 and 5

**Parents**: Help your child to develop a Catholic Christian conscience so they know right from wrong. Discuss some current events. This is a wonderful way to pass on your values. Service is such a vital part of our Christian life. Find ways as a family to reach out and help others. **New prayers to know: Spontaneous prayer: praying in their own words.** 

#### Grade 6,7,8 and (9)

**Parents**: Encourage your child to share his or her thoughts about the homily with you. Attend a wedding, Confirmation, First Communion or Baptism and talk about the experience. **New Prayers to know: The Rosary** 

A vital goal of young adolescent faith formation is the development of their relationship with God so that they may become confident and competent members of their families, Church community and society. The students will be using <u>The Catholic Faith Handbook for Youth</u>. Our goal is to continue to enhance and encourage the spiritual growth of our youth. Emphasis will be placed on understanding the Creed (a statement of our Catholic beliefs), the Liturgy, Sacraments, Christian morality, and prayer.

#### Students in grades 9, 10 through Confirmation

The Confirmation Class will be using Decision Point from Dynamic Catholic. During class the students will participate in prayer, reading, writing, discussion, and activities to continue to grow in an understanding of their faith.

**Parents**: We realize how extremely busy our youth and families are and we acknowledge the tight schedules that the youth have, but at the same time we do emphasize the importance of having faith in their lives. It is essential that you continue to speak and act in a positive way in matters of faith and Church. Lifelong attitudes and habits are formed during these school years and we, as parents and teachers, have the responsibility of guiding our children in all areas of growth. Help him or her with time management and setting priorities. Your support, in words and action, is a positive influence during these important years. Please continue to participate in Mass together each week. Attending other Parish Services together will help you all to grow in faith.

During the year students will have an opportunity to participate in special liturgies, social events, and service projects both at Church and in the Community. Perhaps he or she would like to invite a friend to join into some of these events.

We really want to work closely with your family during these important years to help develop a firm foundation for adult spirituality.

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#### Sacramental Programs

It is required that Children must complete one year of classes prior to entering a Sacramental Program. Second grade, or older, are invited to begin preparing for these sacraments.

**<u>RECONCILIATION</u>**: Commonly referred to as Confession or Penance is a sacramental experience of God's forgiving love.

**<u>EUCHARIST</u>**: Also called Communion is a sacrament of thanksgiving. When the community gathers at Mass we remember and celebrate our love for God and God's love for us.

\*Students preparing for these two sacraments will require additional meeting times. This schedule will be provided separately directly to the parents.

#### **CONFIRMATION:**

\*Preparation is a **2-year program**, beginning in September 2023, with Confirmation being celebrated in the spring of 2025.

\*Students entering the 9<sup>th</sup> grade (or higher) this fall, meet the criteria for this special sacramental class. Please plan to register as this may be a teen's last opportunity to complete the classes.

**Confirmation classes will be held on the same dates and times as all other Faith Formation class days (listed above).** During these classes we will be preparing our youth for the Sacrament of Confirmation.

It is important that every effort be made regarding attendance by each candidate and all classes be attended by each candidate, as we will be covering the materials only once.

### **Program Policies**

All students must be registered to attend classes. A form is available for enrollment. Please remember to register early so that your child can begin classes on time and so that we will have the necessary materials available.

#### Attendance

Regular attendance is expected at all classes and special events. When special circumstances arise affecting attendance, please contact the Director of Faith Formation or your child's teacher to request make-up assignment. #### Cancellations

#### Discipline

Respectful, cooperative, and courteous behavior is expected. Any problems will be handled through a partnership of parents, teachers, students, the Director of Faith Formation and Father Jim.

#### Fee

A registration fee of \$15.00 per student and a family maximum of \$45.00 help to cover the cost of supplies and books that are used. If you have any financial concerns, please contact the Director of Faith Formation and we will certainly work with you.

#### **Other Faith Formation Programs**

**Liturgy of the Word for Children** is a special experience for children ages 3 and up. It is held each Sunday, during the 8:30 am Mass in Whitney Point. The children are dismissed from the congregation before the readings, and they gather in the worship area in the Church Hall. The readings and reflection are specially prepared for children. They receive their own "bulletin" so parents can discuss the message with their children. The children return upstairs after the homily to rejoin their families. No registration is necessary.

Advent and Lenten Events are unique opportunities for all ages and for the entire family. Parents will need to plan on attending with their children. Join us for refreshments and the sharing of several fun, easy, and creative ways to help explore and celebrate the true meaning of Advent and Christmas, Lent, and Easter.

**Vacation Bible School** has traditionally been a one-week program held during the summer. It has not been well attended over the past few years. We are currently exploring new ways to provide a fun summer program for the children that will allow for a greater participation. Stay tuned....

**Adult Education** includes, but is not limited to, seasonal presentations, faith enrichment programs, RCIA for those interested in becoming part of our Catholic Faith community. These are wonderful opportunities for our faith formation and spiritual growth. Regional and diocesan opportunities are posted on the bulletin board and listed in the bulletin as they become available.

**Family Enrichment**: We as a Parish recently purchased a subscription to Formed.org which is a website offering faith based and family friendly reading and listening materials. It has everything imaginable from books to read and download, to music, videos, children's programs, etc. And best of all it is free for all materials.
