

Building Prayer Time @ Home - 2024 - A Year of Prayer

Jesus was praying in a certain place, and when he finished, one of his disciples said to him, "Lord, teach us to pray..." '- Luke 11:1 Alleluia means "Praise the Lord!" It is derived from the Hebrew word "hallelujah." The word first appears in the Bible in Psalm 104:35 and then frequently through the end of the book of Psalms, though it appears nowhere else in the Old Testament. Hallelujah is used twenty-three times and is, in fact, the very last word of the book of Psalms (Ps. 150:6). The Greek form of the word (alleluia) is found in Revelation 19:1, Revelation 19:3, Revelation 19:4, and Revelation 19:6. During this Easter Season, pray with the Psalms.
